Greg Sover Band Returns to Sellersville Theater Show with the Jamie McLean Band celebrates both artists' new releases

The Greg Sover Band, from Philadelphia, is excited to return to Sellersville Theater for their first co-bill performance, which means an opportunity to perform a full 1-hour set. After supporting artists including Indigenous, Ana Popovic and Rusted Root at the renowned theater, the band is ready to showcase material from their new EP Jubilee as well as go deeper into their catalogue.

Sover released **Jubilee** in January and has received airplay locally, nationally and internationally. **Jubilee** peaked at #2 on *The Roots Music Report*'s Top 50 Blues Rock Album Chart for the Week of February 3. *The Roots Music Report*'s Top 50 Blues Rock Song Chart for the same week featured "Emotional" all the way up at #1 plus "As the Years Go Passing By" at #23 and "Jubilee" at #38.

WXPN, Philadelphia's influential public radio station has long supported Sover and has aired four songs from *Jubilee*: "Jubilee," "Emotional," "Hand on My Heart" and "As the Years Go Passing By" – a selection that showcases Sover's diversity. The Greg Sover Band was invited by WXPN's John Vettese, co-host of Philly Local, to record a Key Studio Session for the show to promote the Sellersville Theater show. It will air on Tuesday, February 27th in the 9:00 pm hour.

Jubilee is the long-anticipated follow-up to Songs of a Renegade, Sover's 2016 debut album, which put him on the map and announced that he is one of the top emerging blues/rock artists in Philadelphia and beyond. The band competed at the International Blues Challenge in January, representing the Steel City Blues Society of Phoenixville, PA, and made it into the semifinals. It was a very respectable debut competing against some of the best blues artists in the world.

In addition to widespread airplay, **Jubilee** is also getting great reviews. This is some of what's being said:

"Sover's new E.P. is a follow-up to his awesome 2016 debut, Songs of a Renegade. This is an extremely well-played gaggle of tunes, blues and otherwise, a true celebration... Jubilee is once again produced by Greg Sover Band bassist **Garry Lee** along with Sover. Sover's band of Philly heavyweights with extensive resumes also includes guitarist **Allen James** and drummer **Tom Walling**. The three are best known as Deb Callahan's solid backing band.

The Greg Sover Band is excited to share the stage with the Jamie McLean Band at Sellersville. They are also celebrating a new recording; their album *One and Only* will be released on February 23rd. Jamie McLean is a triple threat. As a guitarist for New Orleans royalty Aaron Neville and the Dirty Dozen Brass Band he has toured the globe playing fiery guitar everywhere from Madison Square Garden to Japan's Fuji Rock. His blue eyed southern soul vocals ooze raw emotion and his top line songwriting chops tie everything together. With hundreds of original compositions to his name McLean creates a musical gumbo that incorporates New Orleans soul, Delta blues, middle America roots and New York City swagger.
